- O You must be signed up with 4-H in the specific project area you would like to exhibit
- 0 Members must own and use their own projects
- O Check with your 4-H Club Leader to make sure you are entering the correct division and class
- 0 Exhibitors must be signed up for Uinta County Fair **ONLINE** at: <u>uinta.fairwire.com</u> by <u>Monday</u>, July 24th

You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: Aerospace, Archery, Cake Decorating, etc.)

You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries

- O You must pick up your exhibit tags on or before <u>Saturday</u>, July 29th to verify correct division/class
- O The main portion of each tag will need to be attached to your project. You will retain the tear-off portion of the tag in order to claim your projects at the end of Fair
- 0 Interview Judging for 4H static exhibits will only be from <u>7:30 10:00 AM Saturday, July 29th</u> (Behind the Exhibit Hall)
- 0 Exhibitors's name must be written on the clipboards by 9:30 AM Saturday, July 29th or they may forfeit the ability to submit their entries.
- O All exhibits must remain for display in the Exhibit Hall throughout the duration of Fair
- 0 Static Exhibits will be released from <u>4:00 6:00 PM Saturday, August 5th</u> (behind the Exhibit Hall) \*\*Don't forget the tear-off portion of your tags to claim your items
- 0 All exhibitors wishing to send items to State Fair must check their items in at Roderick Hall immediately following release of exhibits
