

2021 FFA Static Exhibit Check-list

Contact Uinta County Fair Office with any questions 789-4785

- Review all information on pages: 1-4, 40-41, 57-60
- You must be signed up with FFA in the specific project area you would like to exhibit
- Members must own and use their own projects
- Check with your FFA Advisor to make sure you are entering the correct division and class
- Exhibitors must be signed up for Uinta County Fair **ONLINE** at: uintacountyfair.org by 11:59 p.m. Monday, July 19th
 - You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: Agronomy; Poisonous Plants, Classroom; 3rd Year Record Book, etc.)
 - You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries
- You must pick up your exhibit tags on or before Monday, August 2nd to verify correct division/class
 - The main portion of each tag will need to be attached to your project. You will retain the tear-off portion of the tag in order to claim your projects at the end of Fair
- Exhibits will be accepted in Roderick Hall Saturday, July 31st 9-11 a.m. as well as Monday, August 2nd 11 a.m.-12 p.m.
- Judging for FFA static exhibits will begin at 12 p.m. Monday, August 2nd (In Roderick Hall)
- All exhibits must remain for display in Roderick Hall throughout the duration of Fair
- Static Exhibits will be released from 3-4:30 p.m. Saturday, August 7th (Roderick Hall) ****Don't forget the tear-off portion of your tags to claim your items**
