## 2023 SHEEP Check-list

## Contact Uinta County Fair Office with any questions 783-0314

- O Review all information on pages: 37-40, 54-55
- O You must be signed up with 4-H or FFA in this project area/class in order to show market sheep
- O If you are going to sell a 4-H animal through the Uinta County Jr. Livestock Sale, you must complete a Quality Assurance Training through 4-H
- f O Market lambs must be owned by the exhibitor f AND tagged with a Wyoming State Fair (WSF) tag by f June~1st
  - These tags may be picked up from either the 4-H Office -or- your FFA Advisor, depending on which group you will be showing under
  - For every tag received, a description must be submitted including: exhibitor name, specific animal breed, gender, and color/markings \*\*NO EXCEPTIONS\*\*
- O A USDA scrapie tag must be in the ear of every sheep prior to entering online and must remain in the ear throughout the duration of Fair
- O You must inform your 4-H Club Leader or FFA Advisor of a need for a pen for your market lamb before Friday, July 14th
- O Exhibitors must be signed up for Uinta County Fair **ONLINE** at: uinta.fairwire.org by Wednesday, July 19th
  - You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: market lamb, 4-H/FFA Showmanship, Pen of Three market lambs, breeding sheep, etc.)
  - You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries
- O You must enter ALL tag numbers (WSF & Scrapie) correctly online or your entry will not be accepted
- O Weigh-ins for market sheep will only be from 9:30 11:00 AM Tuesday, August 1st at the livestock barn scale
  - Market sheep must be a minimum weight of 100 pounds at weigh-ins
- O Sheep showmanship will begin at 1:00 PM Wednesday, August 2nd with market lambs immediately following
- O A Junior Livestock Sale Declaration form must be completed, signed by both the exhibitor and a parent, and returned to the Fair Office by 5:00 PM Thursday, August 3th
- O You must secure a bill of sale on your market animal to submit during weigh-ins August 1st
- O All animals must be fed and bedded following the sale Friday, August 4th
- O All breeding sheep must be on grounds by 12:00 PM Saturday, August 5th
- O Breeding sheep showmanship will begin at 12:00 PM Saturday, August 5th and all other breeding sheep classes will follow
- $oldsymbol{0}$  All market lambs returning home must remain on grounds until exhibit release time at 4:00 PM Saturday, August 5th
- O Breeding sheep will be released immediately following the show
- O All exhibitors must check with Livestock Sale Committee before leaving Saturday, August 5th to ensure none of your animals will be left on grounds following Fair
- O All pens must be completely cleaned out <u>Saturday</u>, <u>August 5th</u> prior to leaving the Fairgrounds
