- O You must pick up your exhibit tags on or before <u>Saturday, July 29th</u> to verify correct division/class
- O The main portion of each tag will need to be attached to your project. You will retain the tear-off portion of the tag in order to claim your projects at the end of Fair

- O Judging for FFA static exhibits will begin at 1:00 PM Saturday, July 29th (In Roderick Hall)
