You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: Aerospace, Archery, Cake Decorating, etc.)

You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries

Interview Judging for 4H static exhibits will only be from 7:30- 10 a.m. Monday, August 2nd (Behind the Exhibit Hall)

Exhibitors's name must be written on the clipboards by 9:30 a.m. Monday, August 2nd or they may forfeit the ability to submit their entries.

All exhibits must remain for display in the Exhibit Hall throughout the duration of Fair

Static Exhibits will be released from 3-4:30 p.m. Saturday, August 7th (behind the Exhibit Hall) **Don't forget the tear-off portion of your tags to claim your items

All exhibitors wishing to send items to State Fair must check their items in at Roderick Hall immediately following release of exhibits
