## 2023 SWINE Check-list

## Contact Uinta County Fair Office with any questions 783-0314

- O Review all information on pages: 41-42, 56
- O You must be signed up with 4-H or FFA in this project area/class in order to show market swine
- 0 If you are going to sell a 4-H animal through the Uinta County Jr. Livestock Sale, you must complete a Quality Assurance Training through 4-H
- O Market swine must be owned by the exhibitor AND tagged (with a Wyoming State Fair Tag) by June 1st

These tags may be picked up from either the 4-H Office -or- your FFA Advisor, depending on which group you will be showing under

For every tag received, a description must be submitted including: exhibitor name, specific animal breed, gender, and color/markings \*\*NO EXCEPTIONS\*\*

- O You must inform your 4-H Club Leader or FFA Advisor of a need for a pen for your market swine before Friday, July 14th
- O Exhibitors must be signed up for Uinta County Fair ONLINE at: uinta.fairwire.org by Wednesday, July 19th

You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: market swine, 4-H/FFA Showmanship, Pen of Three market swine, breeding swine, etc.)

You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries

- O You must enter ALL tag numbers (WSF) correctly online or your entry will not be accepted
- O You must secure a bill of sale on your market animal to submit during weigh-ins <u>Tuesday, August 1st</u>
- O Weigh-ins for market swine will only be from <u>7:30 9:30 AM Tuesday, August 1st</u> at the livestock barn scale Market swine must be a minimum weight of 200 pounds at weigh-ins
- 0 Exhibitors must complete the Wyoming Swine Exhibition Declaration form and submit it to the Fair Office anytime between Thursday, July 27th and 4:00 PM Tuesday, August 1st
- 0 Breeding swine will be shown following showmanship, market classes and Pen of Three, and are released immediately following the show
- O Swine showmanship will begin at 4:00 PM Tuesday, August 1st with market swine immediately following
- 0 A Junior Livestock Sale Declaration form must be completed, signed by both the exhibitor and a parent, and returned to the Fair Office by 5:00 PM Thursday, August 3rd
- 0 All animals must be fed and bedded following the sale Friday, August 4th
- 0 All market swine returning home must remain on grounds until exhibit release time at 4:00 PM Saturday, August 5th
- 0 All exhibitors must check with Livestock Sale Committee before leaving Saturday, August 5th to ensure none of your animals will be left on grounds following Fair
- 0 All pens must be completely cleaned out <u>Saturday, August 5th</u> prior to leaving the Fairgrounds
