

2023 SWINE Check-list

- Review all information on pages: 41-42, 56
- You must be signed up with 4-H or FFA in this project area/class in order to show market swine
- If you are going to sell a 4-H animal through the Uinta County Jr. Livestock Sale, you must complete a Quality Assurance Training through 4-H
- Market swine must be owned by the exhibitor **AND** tagged (with a Wyoming State Fair Tag) by June 1st
 - These tags may be picked up from either the 4-H Office -or- your FFA Advisor, depending on which group you will be showing under
 - For every tag received, a description must be submitted including: exhibitor name, specific animal breed, gender, and color/markings ****NO EXCEPTIONS****
- You must inform your 4-H Club Leader or FFA Advisor of a need for a pen for your market swine before Friday, July 14th
- Exhibitors must be signed up for Uinta County Fair **ONLINE** at: uinta.fairwire.org by Wednesday, July 19th
 - You will need to sign up for each individual class you wish to show in (ie: market swine, 4-H/FFA Showmanship, Pen of Three market swine, breeding swine, etc.)
 - You will receive an emailed receipt of all your entries. If you do not receive one, please contact the Fair Office to verify entries
- You must enter **ALL** tag numbers (WSF) correctly online or your entry will not be accepted
- You must secure a bill of sale on your market animal to submit during weigh-ins Tuesday, August 1st
- Weigh-ins for market swine will only be from 7:30 - 9:30 AM Tuesday, August 1st at the livestock barn scale
 - Market swine must be a minimum weight of 200 pounds at weigh-ins
- Exhibitors must complete the Wyoming Swine Exhibition Declaration form and submit it to the Fair Office anytime between Thursday, July 27th and 4:00 PM Tuesday, August 1st
- Breeding swine will be shown following showmanship, market classes and Pen of Three, and are released immediately following the show
- Swine showmanship will begin at 4:00 PM Tuesday, August 1st with market swine immediately following
- A Junior Livestock Sale Declaration form must be completed, signed by both the exhibitor and a parent, and returned to the Fair Office by 5:00 PM Thursday, August 3rd
- All animals must be fed and bedded following the sale Friday, August 4th
- All market swine returning home must remain on grounds until exhibit release time at 4:00 PM Saturday, August 5th
- All exhibitors must check with Livestock Sale Committee before leaving Saturday, August 5th to ensure none of your animals will be left on grounds following Fair
- All pens must be completely cleaned out Saturday, August 5th prior to leaving the Fairgrounds
