

2021 Uinta County Fair Items to Note

- Refer to Livestock Checklist for individual species at uintacountyfair.org
- **HEALTH INSPECTIONS** must be completed by Monday, July 19th. These forms will be printed in duplicate; white copy will be retained by Vet Clinics, yellow copy is for exhibitor's record. Fair Staff will collect health inspections directly from all three Uinta County Vet Clinics on Tuesday, July 20th at 8:00 AM. If animals are inspected at another location, said Vet Clinic must fax (307-789-6312) Health Inspections directly to the Fair Office by Tuesday, July 20th at 8:00 AM. This ruling is required of **EVERY** animal being brought to the Uinta County Fair.
- The fairgrounds will be locked down from Sunday, July 25th at 8:00 AM through Wednesday, July 28th at 12:00 Noon for final set-up and preparations for fair.
- Livestock will be allowed on grounds as of Wednesday, July 28th at 12:00 Noon, at the owner's risk as the grounds will not be patrolled until Monday, August 2nd.
- All horses must be out of the horse barn and stalls cleaned out by Tuesday, August 3rd at 2:00 PM. After August 3rd at 2:00 PM stalls on the outside of the barn may be used during fair on a first come first serve basis.
- Sawdust is required to be used in all trays for rabbit and poultry cages.
- All cages, stalls, and pens **MUST** be cleaned out 100% before the exhibitor may leave the grounds on August 7th. This includes all decorations being removed.
- An exhibitor must enter ALL animals that have been tagged with a Wyoming State Fair Tag and will no longer be required to declare online which two animals (per species) that will be brought to fair. This ruling has been in place since the 2018 Uinta County Fair. The exhibitor must declare animals (per species) prior to entering the scales. The exhibitor will **ONLY** be allowed to weigh two animals in (per specie). If one of the animals weighed-in is under weight, they may **NOT** trade or weigh another in its place.
